



COURSE BROOK FARM LESSON RULES

1. **Please be on time.** Please plan to arrive at least 20-30 minutes ahead of your scheduled lesson time to tack up. And don't forget to leave at least 15-20 minutes to put your horse away (cool, dry and no sweat marks). All bits need to be rinsed off and bridles wiped and put away neatly. Tacking up and un-tacking are not part of your lesson. Those students, who do not know how to do these two tasks proficiently, will be required to pay for a minimum of 4- 1 hr lessons in order to learn how to do this on their own.
2. **Payment is due at the time of service.** If you would like to pay for lessons in bulk, you may pay **ahead** of time for packages of 4 lessons. Please ask about special payment arrangements and discount packages.
3. **Cancellation policy:** please be aware of the fact that instructors make their living teaching you! Canceling your scheduled lesson not only affects your instructor, but the farm and the person whose horse you are riding (if not your own). If you need to cancel a lesson, please try to give at least 24-hr. notice. If less than 24-hr notice is given, you may be subject to a partial payment or fee. An exception may be made for sudden illness or extreme weather or at the discretion of your instructor.
4. Those customers seeking regular weekly lessons will be given priority in the lesson schedule.
5. An approved safety helmet and boots or shoes with heels are required at all times when mounted.
