



FARM OPERATIONS AND RULES

Hours

- Monday – Saturday: 7:00am-9:00pm
- Sunday: 7:00am-7:00pm
- Closed on Thanksgiving and Christmas
- Notices about closings or extended hours will be made via e-mail and on the boarder Facebook page.
- With the exception of medical emergencies, boarders are expected to adhere to closing hours.
 - Anyone at the barn after hours is responsible for closing up and turning off all lights before leaving.

Turnout

- Horses are turned out daily, weather permitting.
- Turnout begins at 7:00am, and turning in begins at 2:00pm.
- Horses will be turned out in paddocks assigned by the barn manager. CBF reserves the right to make paddock assignment changes as needed. Turnout preferences will be taken into consideration, but cannot be guaranteed.
- Notices about changes in turnout routine will be made via e-mail.
- If your horse needs to remain in, please communicate that via e-mail (no later than 2:30p the previous day) or under the “No Turnout” section of the large white board in the main barn aisle.
- Do not leave one horse alone in turnout, especially in the paddocks down the road. If only your horse and one other are out, please inform CBF Staff, so they can retrieve the other horse.
- Do not turn your horse back out after 1:00pm.

Rules

General:

- No smoking or drinking alcoholic beverages on the premises.
- Children must be supervised at all times.
- Parking is restricted to the gravel lot by the shed-rows, next to the main barn. Please do not park anywhere else, with the exception of a brief period necessary for drop-offs or pick-ups.
- Dogs must be approved by the barn manager and remain on-leash and under control at all times.
- Your guests are your responsibility and must be made aware of and adhere to farm rules.
- Clean up after yourself and your horse.
- Turn off lights when an area is no longer in use.
- Keep your designated tack space clean and orderly.
- Do not put your horse in any other stall but its own for any reason or length of time, with the exception of an emergency or approval from barn manager.
- If additional shavings / hay are required, ask CBF staff. Do not take them yourself.
- Do not alter CBF property in any way without express permission from CBF management.
- Keep grooming boxes and other items out of the aisles; place in your horse’s stall or designated tack area.
- Bring any problems to the attention of CBF management. **We cannot resolve problems we are not aware of.**

Riding:

- When possible, tack up in your horse’s stall, to keep the aisle clear for traffic.
- Anyone who rides on CBF property must sign a liability release form prior to mounting.
- Approved safety helmets and appropriate footwear are required when riding.
- Safety vests are required when jumping any obstacles on the XC course.
- No minor may jump on CBF property unless under the supervision of a licensed professional or adult.
- Outside instructors are prohibited, unless approved by CBF management.
